Year 12 and 13 – Super-Curricular Visit to London
Thursday 20th November to Saturday 22nd November 2025

Dear Parent/ Carer,

We are delighted to be able to offer students at Beverley Joint 6th the opportunity to spend a weekend in London in November 2025. Students will be supporting staff to plan the final itinerary linked to their choice of A level subjects but examples of activities could include visits to the Design Museum, the British Museum or the Imperial War Museum.

We hope to leave Hull at approximately 17.00 on Thursday 20th November and return to Hull at approximately 21.00 on Saturday 22nd November. Accommodation will be at Earl's Court Youth Hostel and students will be in shared rooms of 4-5 students. Travel whilst in London will be by underground or bus. **The cost of the visit is expected to be £250.**

This price includes:

- **Return travel from Hull to London by train**
- **Accommodation and all meals on Friday and breakfast on Saturday**
- **All activities**
- **Insurance cover**

Students will be expected to cover the cost of any other meals, snacks and drinks during the visit.

In order to facilitate travel in London we will be asking students to pay for their own travel within London using a debit or oyster card. We anticipate that this cost will be around £10.

We are seeking expressions of interest in the trip now using this link <https://forms.gle/zaPCMtMPoqYCkvMN9> or the QR code at the bottom of this letter by **Monday 14th July 2025**. Once we have confirmed that the visit can go ahead, payment for the trip will open on **Tuesday 15th July 2025**. A deposit of **£80.00** will be required to secure a place on the trip and this should be paid by Parent Pay at BHS or BGS for by **Friday 18th July**. **Any students who are not currently studying at BGS/BHS should contact the J6th office at either school to arrange to make payment.** The school reserves the right to cancel a student's place on the visit if the behaviour of the student is of such concern that it is the view of the Headteacher that the risk to health and safety of the student and/or others on the visit would be compromised if that student was allowed to accompany the trip.

It is possible to pay the full amount in one payment but if parents prefer to pay in instalments the balance of the money will be due as follows: **£70** to be paid to the relevant school's Finance Office by **Friday 3rd October**, **£100** to be paid to the relevant school's Finance Office by **Friday 7th November**.

Please note that if a Year 12 student is not able to or chooses not to take up their place at Beverley Joint Sixth then they will not be able to take part in the visit. A full refund of any monies paid will be paid to parents.
