Opportunities Post 16 Evening - Thursday 25 November 2021

As you are aware, your child will soon be making some very important decisions about their future education or career.

In order to help them make an informed choice, it is important that they investigate all avenues open to them. With this in mind, Beverley High School and Beverley Grammar School will be holding a Joint Sixth Form Open Evening on Thursday 25 November. The venue is Beverley Grammar School and all Year 11 students are invited to attend with one parent.

There will be no general talk this year but you are invited to watch the videos on the J6 website. Both Headteachers provide an insight into sixth form life and study, whilst the Head Girl and Boy team have provided a brief site tour of Beverley High School. Miss Gardiner and Miss Butlin have also provided a presentation of our super curricular programme in J6. A Level teachers from both schools will be available to provide information on all courses available including our A Level offering and the three enrichment options - Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), Core Mathematics and Languages for Business (a new level 3 qualification we are offering this year). Our teachers and current sixth form students will also be available to give you the information you need and to answer any specific questions that you may have. The Beverley Grammar School site can be accessed through the pedestrian gate at the front of the school. Please proceed to the main building and enter the main hall via the side entrance nearer the pavilion. You will be met by members of the J6 team, the Headteachers and other key J6 staff. We will provide you with a pack containing relevant information for the night including a map indicating where staff are located, a frequently asked question document, a timeline for applications and a copy of our latest newsletter. Please sign in, collect your pack and then make your way to talk to the teachers of the subjects you are interested in finding out about. Whilst the majority of subjects are located in the main area of the school Fine Art, Photography, Textiles, Psychology and EPQ are based in the Art block. This is the original school building when the school was first on this site and is by the pedestrian gate. We recommend you visit this building towards the end of your visit. We ask that you remain no longer than one hour on the site where possible.
