

## PROVISIONAL CHOICE OF YEAR 12 COURSES FOR SEPTEMBER 2020

- In the grid overleaf are the subjects that may be available to students entering Year 12 in September 2020. There have been some changes since the first consultation with students; some subjects have been added to the options and some have been removed
- They have been arranged in 4 blocks that will allow students to access popular combinations of subjects and a broad range of subject areas. The choices that students indicated in the first expressions of interest have been taken into account
- It may be that some of these subjects will not eventually be on offer in September if insufficient students opt for them

- It is expected that most students will take 3 subjects in the 6<sup>th</sup> form. We are happy to discuss the possibility of taking 4 subjects if students are interested in this option; please indicate on your form what your 4<sup>th</sup> subject would be and your reasons for studying it
- You should pick no more than one subject from any subject block
- If you have difficulty in fitting your choice of subjects into the blocks, please use the space at the bottom of the page to give details of your problem
- Indicate your preferred choice of Enrichment option.
