Create a visual journal



Keep a journal across the summer to record of the things that you find visually or conceptually interesting. It does not need to flow or have a theme.

You should include drawings, photographs and ephemera. The drawings can be quick expressions through to detailed drawings. You may also want to collage, paint, sew or create work in other ways in the book.

You can use an existing sketchbook, book or make your own journal using found papers. You may wish to add flaps, pop-outs, pockets or simply use the book as it is. Consider what you might like to make work onto as you could include leaves, fabric, cardboard and more.
